



How To Winterize Your RV Check List

Be Safe

- Be aware of power
- Disconnect from water sources.
- Water pump if off
- Water heater is turned off/cooled down

Tools you may need.

- [RV Antifreeze](#) – we use 10L
- Crescent Wrench
- Flashlight
- siphoning kit if your RV does not have one
- water heater by pass kit if you do not have one

Winterizing Checklist

- Drain your wastewater tanks.
- Drain your freshwater tank(s).
- Open your low point drains.
- Open your hot water tank plug.

IMPORTANT: Ensure that your water heater has been turned off and has had enough time to cool down. Draining a heated tank can be dangerous and could result in burns.

- Close your low point drain.
- Enable by-pass for hot water tank.
- Prep your antifreeze hookup to your pump and close off fresh water.
- Turn on pump and open kitchen faucet
- Open/close other faucets in sequence
- Ensure you check other water outlets

Other items to consider during winterization

- Mouse Proof your RV
- Wipe down your fridge and leave open
- Vacuum, especially in corners
- Hide all paper products
- Disconnect batteries and/or remove them
- Double check tire pressure

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
